


Provider Alliance Boundary: York City North



York Summary

- York has 208,367 residents with 5.7% from a black and minority ethnic community group. 83.9% are in good health, with 15.3% stating that they have some limitation in day to day activities.
- 66% own their own home, either outright or with a mortgage, 18% are private renters and 14% are social tenants.
- 73.5% of residents have a NVQ level 1 - 4 qualification and 18.0% have no qualifications at all.
- 9.7% of children are in child poverty (7.8% of children live in a household where a parent or guardian claims an out-of-work benefit) and there are 11.5% of households in fuel poverty.
- 1.7% of the working population (aged 16-64) claim out of work benefits and 0.2% claim job seekers allowance.


Includes the following wards: Clifton, Haxby and Wigginton, Rawcliffe and Clifton Without, Strensall.

- York City North has 42,210 residents with 7.76% from a black and minority ethnic community group. 84.0% are in good health, with 15.5% stating that they have some limitation in day to day activities.
- 75% own their own home, either outright or with a mortgage, 14% are private renters and 10% are social tenants.
- 72.9% of residents have a NVQ level 1 - 4 qualification and 18.7% have no qualifications at all.
- 7.7% of children live in poverty and there are 9.5% of households in fuel poverty.
- 0.3% of the working population claim out of work benefits and 0.1% claim job seekers allowance.


Population by Age
















Benefit Claimant Rate - Working age population (16-64)




Total Benefit Claimant Rate by Age and Gender - Working age population (16-64)



JSA Claimant Rate by Age and Gender - Working age population (16-64)











Births - Live births per 1,000 women (age 15 - 44 years)




Children and Young People Hospital Admissions






5 year aggregated data 2011/12 - 2015/16


Mortality


Premature Mortality






Crime and Anti-Social Behaviour

Crime rate per 1,000 population





Average Weekly Homecare Hours by Client Type and Age




Average Number of Homecare Clients by Type and Age




Average Score Recorded by Customers for Supported Self Assessments Completed in Period






Resident satisfaction responses about their local area



Resident responses about the local economy




Resident satisfaction responses about Public Realm in their Local Area




York Council House Tenants Satisfied with.....
